



## Spend your summer with University of Wisconsin, Madison, exploring what it means to live, learn and become a college student.

Badger Summer Scholars is a transformative residential college preparatory experience for students in **9th through 12th grade** (15-18 approximately). Through meeting with and learning from UW experts in various fields and academic areas of interest, applicants will explore the college application process and experience a taste of what it means to live and learn like a college student. Applicants should be ready to take the next step in their journey and to engage in a rewarding college program with peers from all over the USA.

### Why BSS?

Participants in the program will learn what it is like to be a Badger and gain valuable experience living and learning in a dynamic and challenging environment, all while interacting with UW–Madison staff and Badger Precollege instructors at a top-ranked university. Our high school students will have the opportunity to learn about the college admissions process, financial aid applications, campus life and more. Our courses showcase the many topics students can study in college, giving students an advantage in deciding their college major.

### What to expect

Students are in class each weekday with a morning class session, afternoon class session, and a required study session immediately after. Once a week students spend their afternoons in our Jump Forward series, designed to help students understand various college admissions and student life topics. Class sizes are kept small to allow for an engaging course and are taught by UW–Madison staff and Badger Precollege instructors who have the same level of commitment and involvement for Badger Summer Scholars as they would from college students. In class you will utilize campus resources, become a more independent learner and increase your confidence in approaching challenging academic tasks. By the end of the program, you should notice better time management skills when handling complex projects and an improved understanding of yourself, your strengths and your talents!

Residential students experience what it is like to live in the dorm and form lasting friendships through free time and coordinated activities while exploring the UW-Madison campus and surrounding areas.

### Dates & Price:

**6<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025**, with junior summer school (homestay) at our Madison school from 06 to 20/07, followed by Badger Summer School, **US\$7665**. Chicago airport transfer included.

UW-Madison summer school only, 20<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025, \$4700. Does not include transfers.
